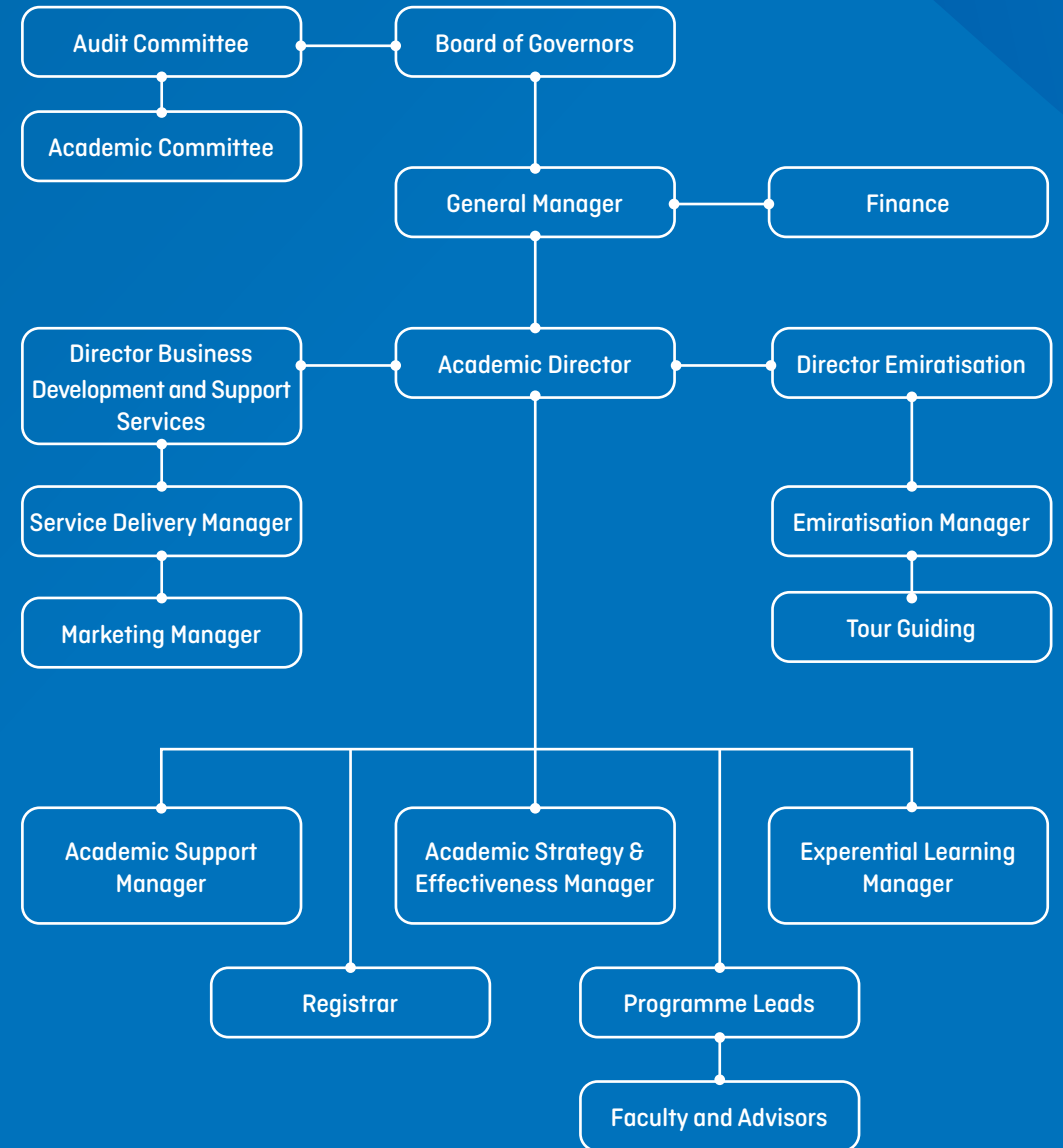

PROGRAMMES OFFERED (2022-23)

DCT offers certificate and Level 5 Award courses in four core subject areas: tourism, hospitality, culinary arts and events. The programmes follow the National Qualifications Framework for the UAE (QFEmirates) and are approved by the Ministry of Education (NQC L4) (NQC L5).

1. Tourism Programmes:

- Certificate 4 in Tourism Operations
- Level 5 Award for Tourism Supervisors

2. Hospitality Programmes:

- Certificate 4 in Hospitality Operations
- Level 5 Award for Hospitality Supervisors

3. Events Programmes:

- Certificate 4 for Events Coordinators
- Level 5 Award in Event Organisation

4. Culinary Arts Programmes:

- Certificate 4 in Culinary Operations
- Level 5 Award in Culinary Arts

The vocational training on offer has been designed in partnership with the industry; students gain practical experience through internships that lead to jobs after completion of the course, as well as enhanced future opportunities for progression within the industry.

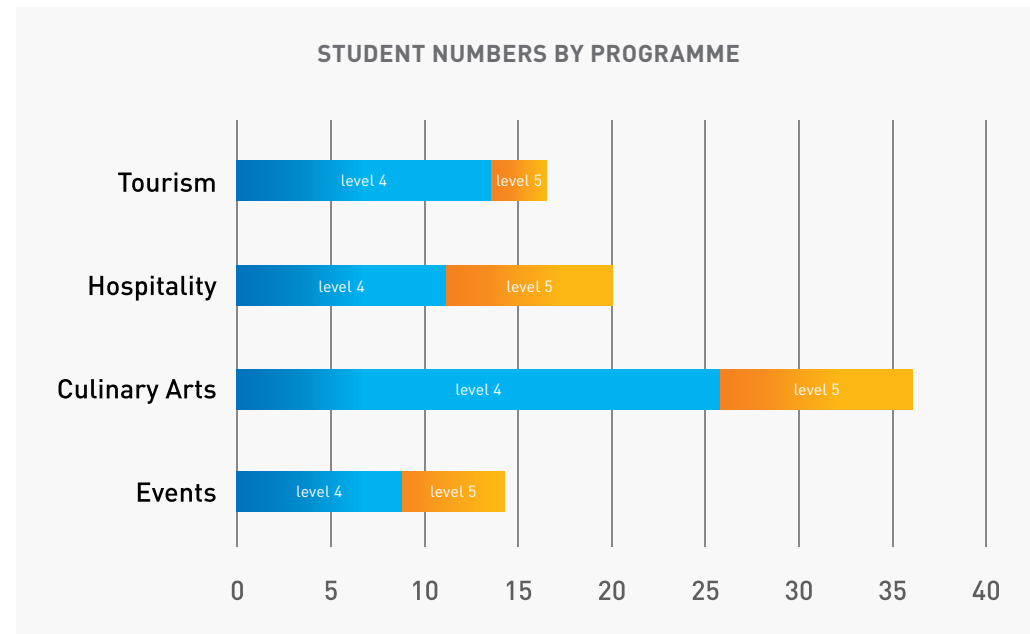

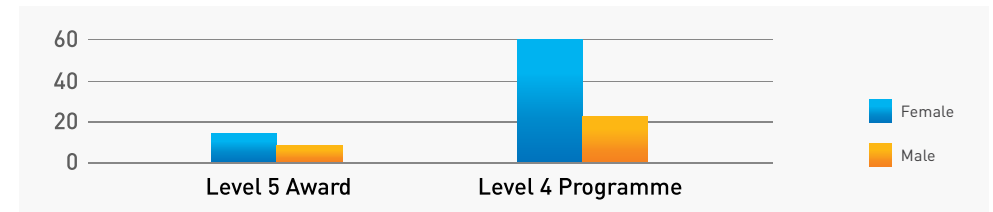

Student enrollment by Programme and Level

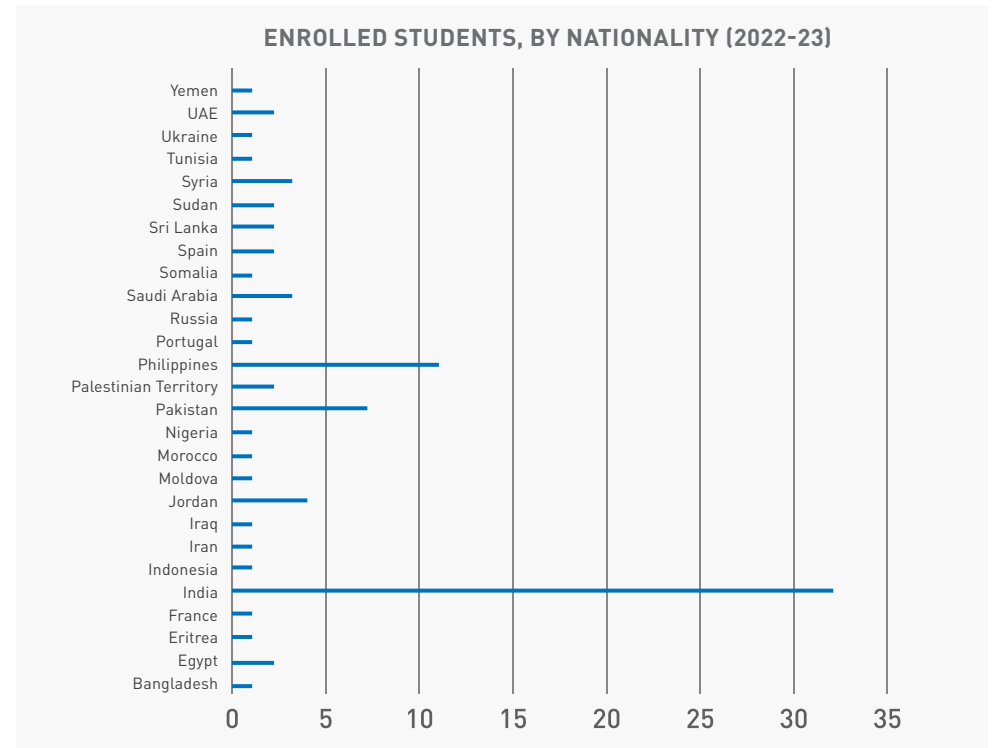


Gender mix across programme levels

DCT takes pride in its inclusive student demographic, characterized by a diverse array of individuals representing a multitude of nationalities.



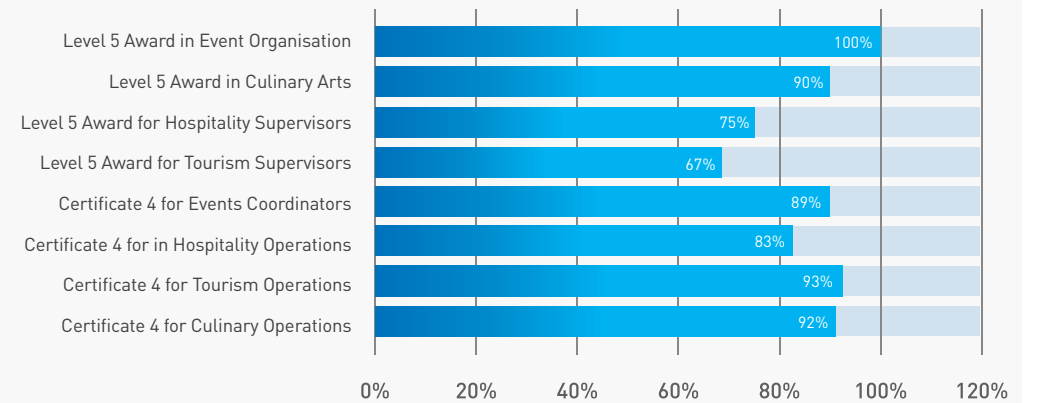

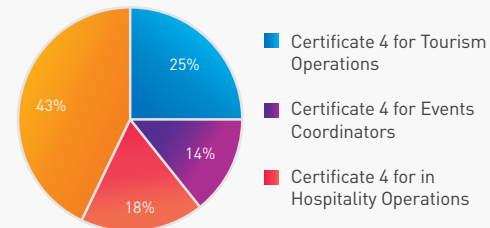

Graduation rate by Programme

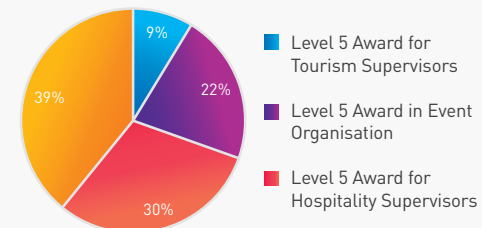


Split of graduates by Programme Area

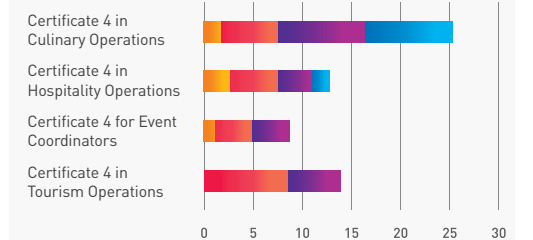


LEVEL 5 GRADUATES

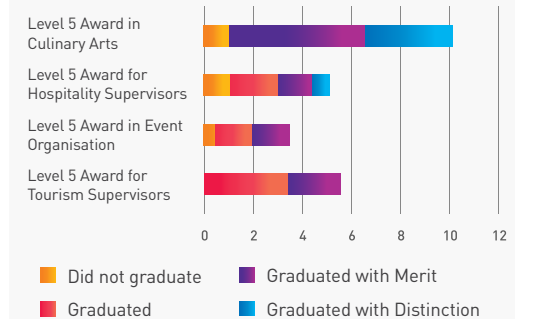


Split of graduates by Grades achieved

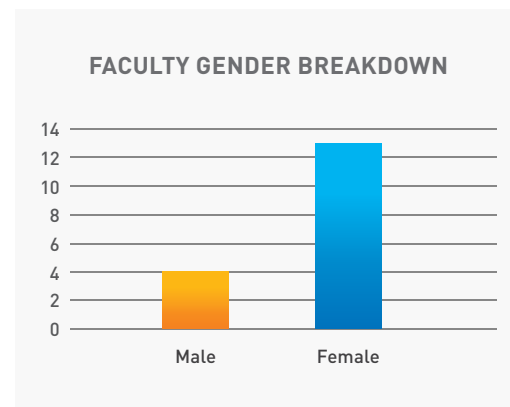

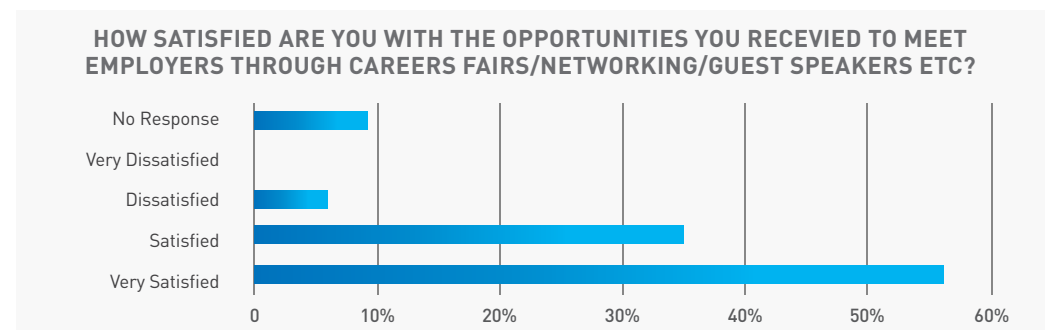
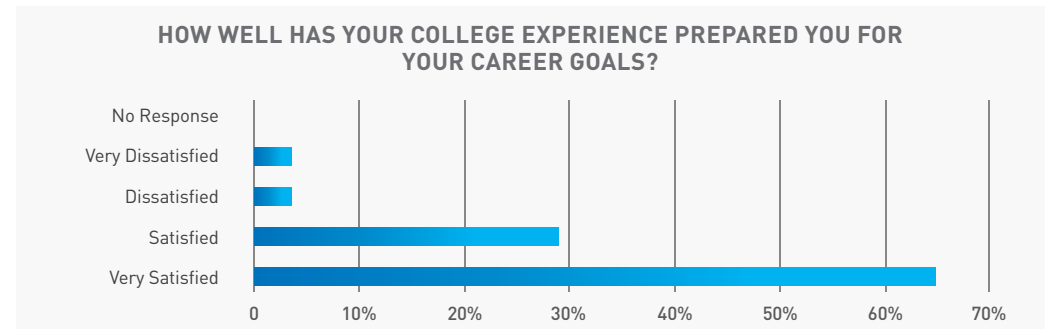
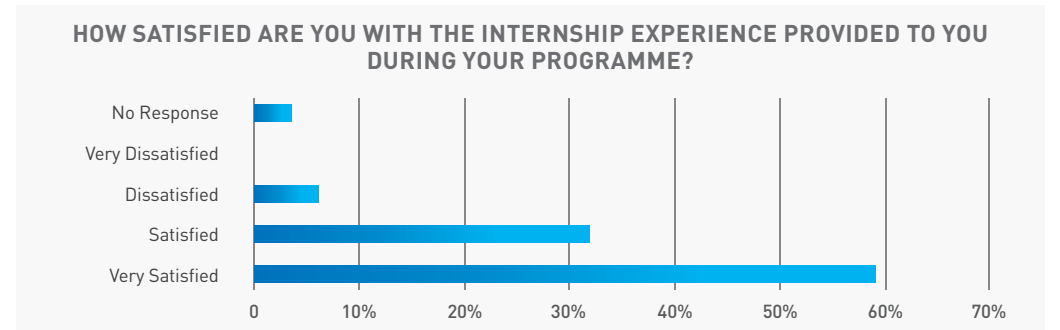
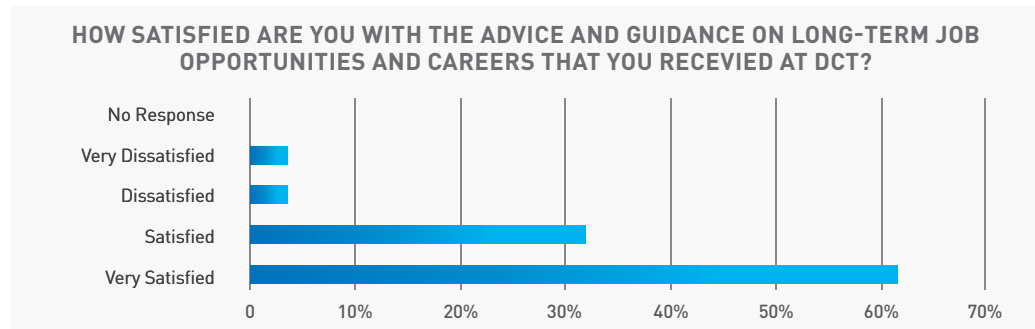
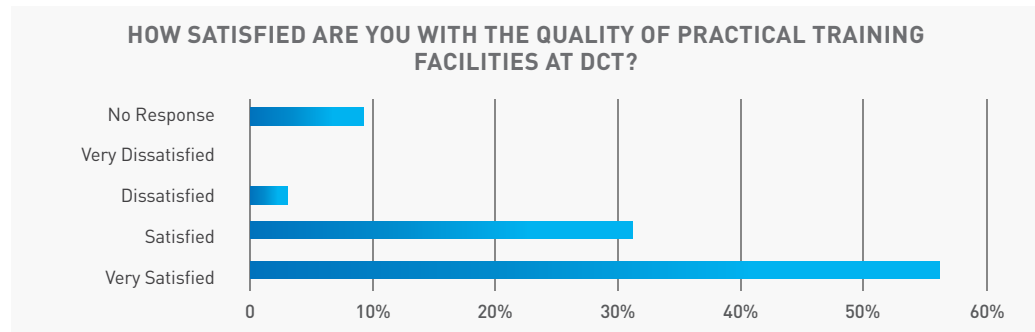
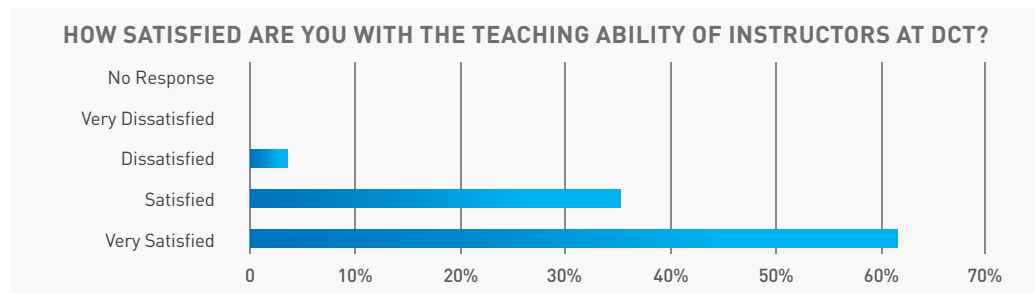
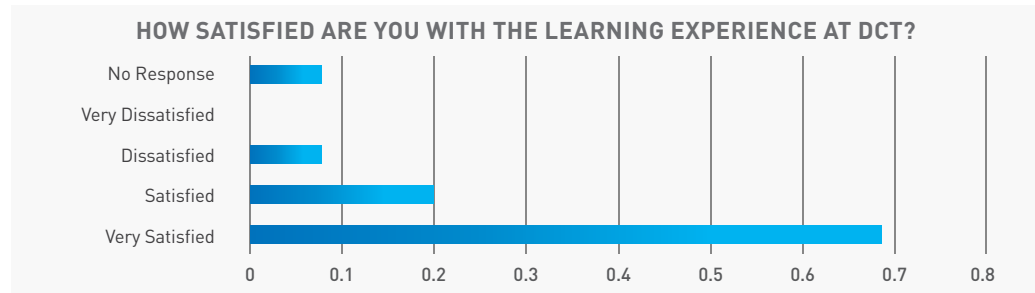
An anonymous survey was administered at the end of the year prior to graduation, and here are some key highlights.
